



## Overseas Travel Assistance Policy

The aim of this Policy is to encourage Cub Scouts/Scouts/Explorer Scouts and Networks within the Enfield District to engage in visits and adventurous activities abroad.

The leader in charge must familiarise themselves with the relevant rules in POR (currently Rule 9.64 Visits Abroad)

This will be achieved by:

1. Application for overseas travel being made to the District Commissioner at the earliest opportunity before the travel date. (Ideally 6-12 months)
2. The application will outline the location and objectives of the visit, anticipated number of participants, Leader in charge and supporting leaders, cost including breakdown of self funding, sponsorship and any other anticipated significant costs, dates of travel and return. A copy of the Associations TA Form would be advisable.
3. The District Commissioner will, if satisfy with the legitimacy and planning of the proposed event, bring the application to the District Executive to approve District funding. The District will normally cover the insurance costs.
